Phase 1

Engagement of local young people, building rapport, increasing our knowledge and consultation with the local community.

Collecting information and feeding it back - allows us to build local trust with young people

Baseline activity of a minimum of 12 hours delivery per week in each hub.

Phase 2

Enhanced offer that has been co-produced and created by local young people.

Employability workshops for young people, with two employability strands delivered in each hub per term, one for primary age pupils and one for secondary age pupils.

Hope to have built local trust and rapport.

Phase 3

Developing new opportunities, new experiences and planning for beyond August 2019.

Community movement of young people created locally and citywide connections made.

A large scale festival for the city, bringing all communities together with Derby's first ever mass sport, arts and culture festival.

Trust built - and beginning to become sustained.
