Beginning in Westfield Derby, a group of silver explorers will lead audiences into the Cathedral Quarter for the rest of the weekend's activities.

Four tall, mysterious figures emerge in the Cathedral Quarter, charming us into following them to Cathedral Green where they transform into 4 metre high unearthly beings. To bewitching music, they perform a magical ritual that releases their star into the night sky.

At the finale of *Herbert's Dream*, *The World Famous* will create a dazzling shower of light marking the beginning of another Festé weekend!

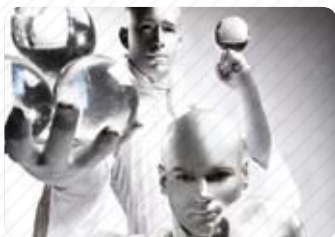
M Addictive TV BBC Big Screen, Market Place
